Some chiropractic procedures are deemed “unproven” by the Colorado State Board of Chiropractic Examiners. Unproven procedures are those where the effectiveness has not been demonstrated and include, but are not limited to, dry needling points outside the scope of homeostatic points, soft or cold laser for uses not approved by the FDA: diagnostic spinal ultrasound for the use of diagnosing inflammation, swelling or other pathology; and any practice system that does not include a complete evaluation, generally recognized in the profession, and represented as a means of attaining spiritual growth, comfort, or well-being.
